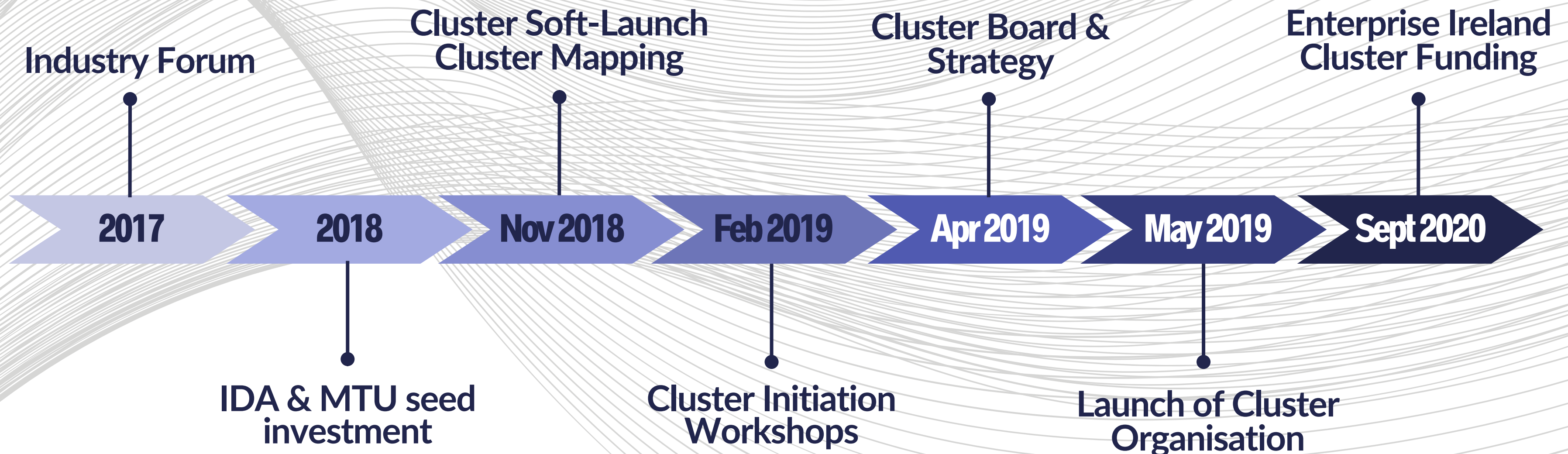

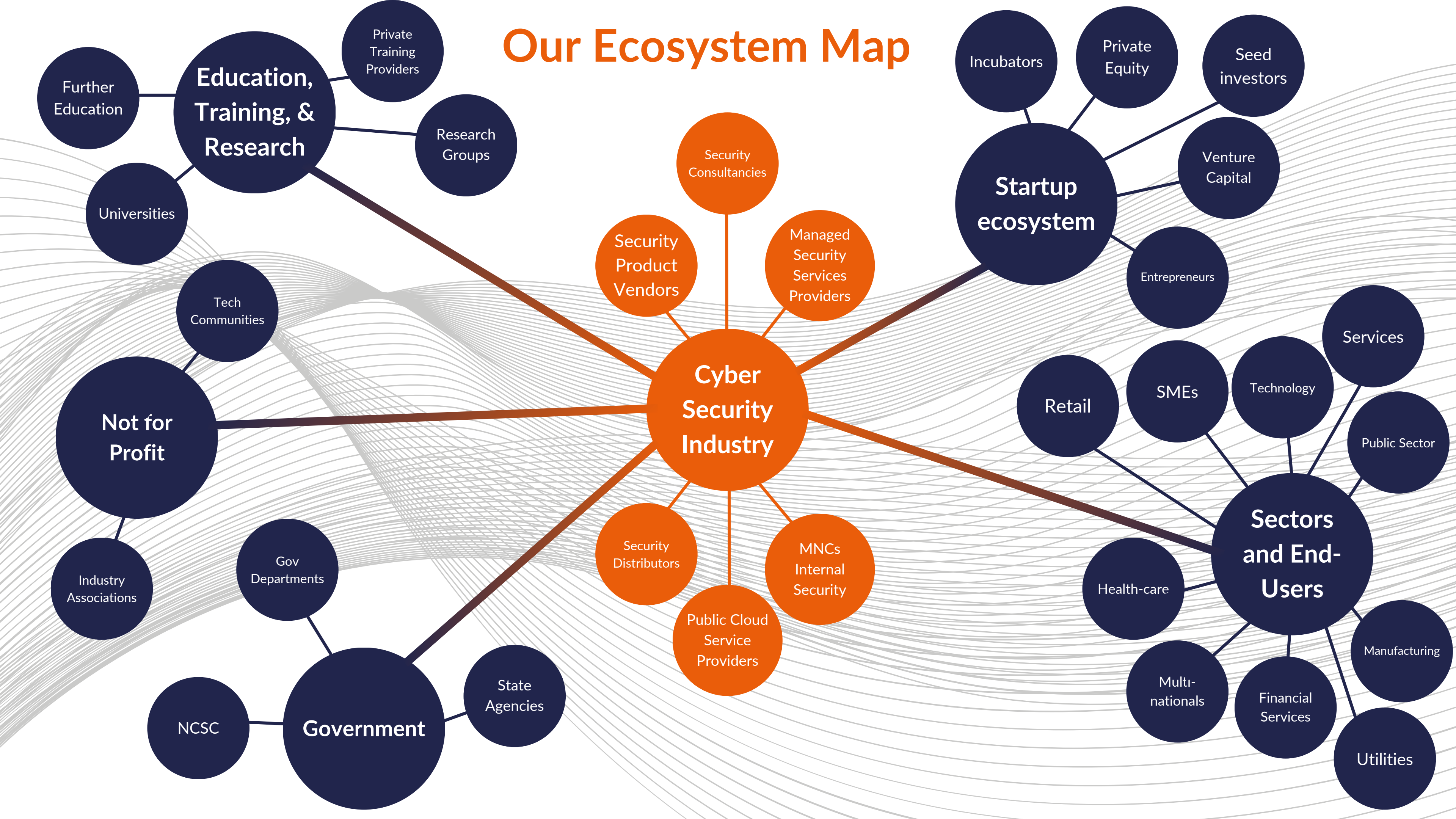

An industry forum was held in April 2017 to address the cyber security skills shortage. A recommendation was made by industry to establish a cyber security representative body to coordinate the cyber security ecosystem at a national level, address common challenges and realise our Cyber Potential.

The sector employs **7,351** cyber security professionals in Ireland.



489 firms in Ireland employ staff in internal cyber security operations or offer cyber security products or services to the market.



It is estimated that in 2021 the Irish cyber sector generated approx. **€2.1bn** in revenue & **€1.1bn** in GVA.

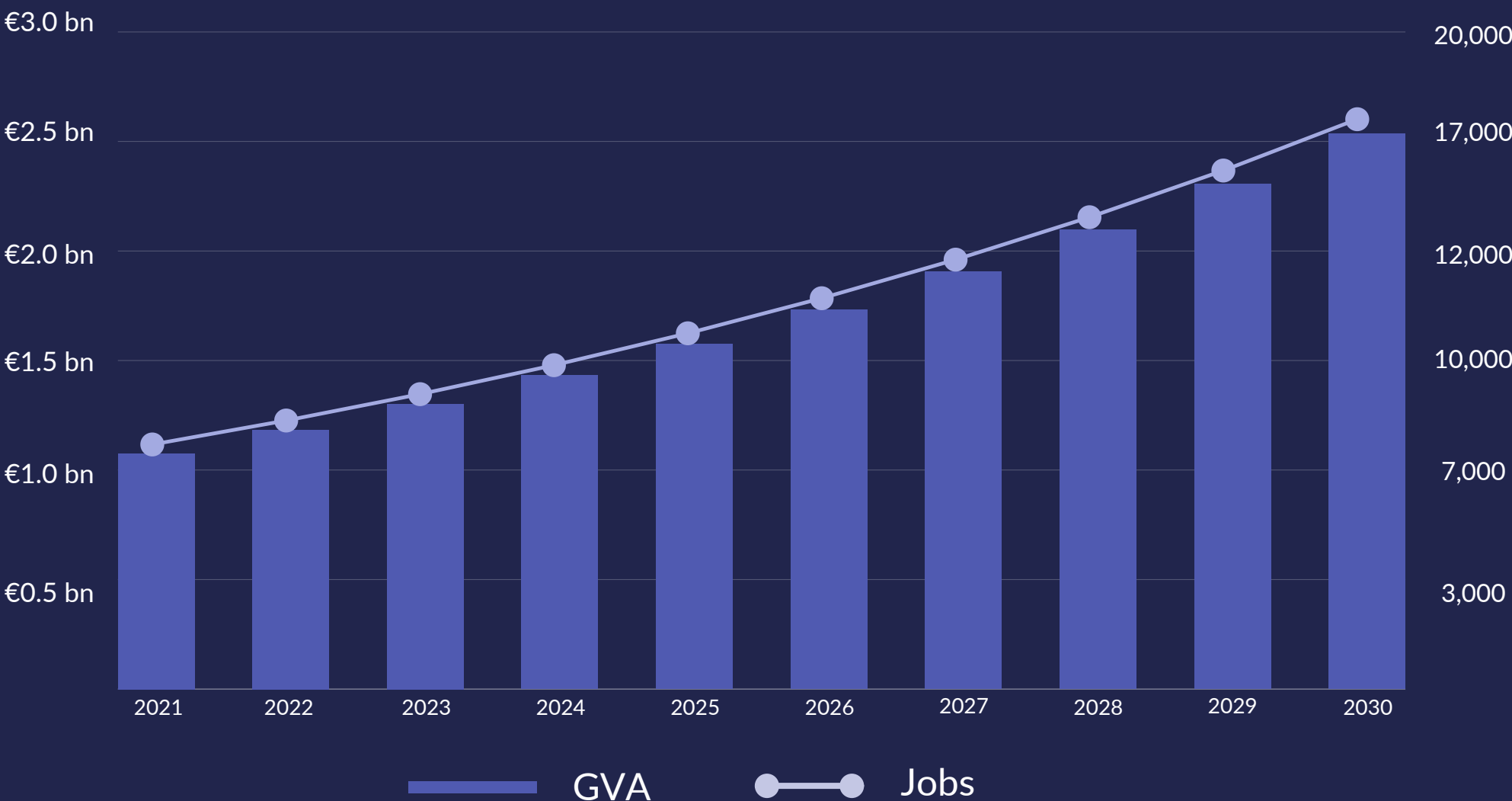
GROWTH PROJECTIONS BY 2030

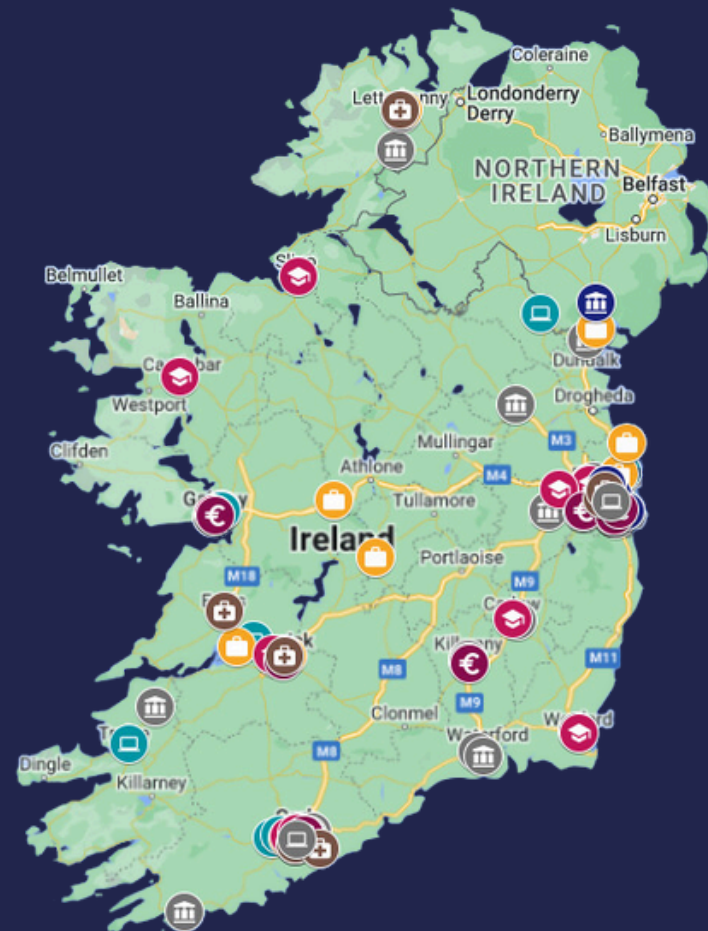

Who can Join?



Membership is open to companies and organisations (not individuals) which are deemed to provide cyber security products and/or services, or play an important role in Ireland's cyber security sector, including government agencies and knowledge providers.

Organisations must have operations, or be registered, in Ireland.

The List of Cyber Security Operations Include:

- Managed security service provision (MSSP) and advisory services
 - Governance, Risk, compliance, and fraud
 - Securing applications, networks, and cloud environments
 - Operational technology, security, and connected devices
 - Threat intelligence, monitoring, detection, and analysis
 - Identification, authentication, and access control
 - Other firms - cyber security recruitment, professional services, firms developing security solutions for internal use only, firms securing systems internally, or those with teams dedicated to trust and safety of end-user data.
